Facility is a fenced garden situated along the Chinook Parkway. Located on Walker Street, south of Chaplin Street East and 12th Ave NE. Open from 7:30 am-9:00 pm or dusk. May 1st to October 31st

[Terms and Conditions](#)

1. All payments and booking arrangements to be made with the City of Swift Current Community Services Division.
2. Pay the specified rental fee for a raised garden box. Fees are non-refundable.
3. Gardeners are responsible for their own gardening tools and off-site storage. Storage will not be provided on-site.
4. Gardening ornaments are at your own risk. Solar Lights are not permitted
5. Complete and submit the Janie and Helen Rempel Community Garden User Agreement before gardening.
6. Have your box planted by **June 10th** and cleaned up by **October 31st** of the annual gardening season.
7. Provide an active email address and phone number.
8. Notify the City promptly if any contact information changes.
9. Gardeners in good standing can retain their garden box from year to year if payment is received before the deadline of April 1st.
10. If payment is not received before the April 1st deadline, the licensee will be treated as a new gardener and may have a different garden box assignment.
11. New gardeners on the waiting list will be allocated a garden box on a first-come-first served basis based on availability.

12. Read and abide by these Terms and Conditions, User Agreement and the Code of Conduct.

Code of Conduct

1. Pets are not permitted inside the fence.
2. Children must be supervised at all times.
3. Smoking is not permitted inside the fence.
4. Harvest only crops grown in your garden box.
5. Maintain your assigned garden box according to the user agreement:
 - a. Be considerate of neighboring garden boxes
 - b. Keep garden box and the area around the box free of weeds.
 - c. Keep area between your garden box and adjacent boxes clean of refuse.
 - d. If you are unable to maintain your box, notify the City in a timely manner.
 - e. If your garden box does not appear to be cared for you will be given notice. If the conditions are not addressed within **2** weeks the produce in the plot will be harvested and donated to a charitable organization. The user will forfeit their gardening privileges.

Rates

A damage deposit of \$50.00 is required at booking. The damage deposit is held to cover clean-up costs if the plot is abandoned. The deposit can be carried over from year to year.
