- All members of council have filed and annually updated their Public Disclosure Statements, as required;
- That council understands that if any requirements are not met, the Municipalities Revenue Sharing Grant may be withheld until all requirements are met; and

the City Clerk be authorized to sign the Declaration of Eligibility and submit it to the Ministry of Government Relations."
