ITEMS FOR ACTION

CORPORATE SERVICES

City Council approved spending in the amount of \$2,203,840.21 for the period of March 11th – 24th, 2021.

City Council approved an amendment to the City's Municipal Economic Enhancement Program 2020 Funding Agreement with the Government of Saskatchewan. Excess funds from the Friesen Street Storm Rehabilitation Project were reallocated to fund the replacement of Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus and the Stockade Floor Replacement.

INFRASTRUCTURE & OPERATIONS

City Council awarded a one-year contract to Swift Kerb to operate the City's Yard Waste Collection Sites from April 17th to October 31st, 2021.

City Council approved the termination of the Challenge Funding Agreement regarding Gasification of Recycled Fibres to Combined Heat and Power, under the Low Carbon Economy Fund, with Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Canada.

PLANNING & GROWTH DEVELOPMENT

City Council gave Notice of Motion of Council's intent to make textual amendments to the Zoning Bylaw in relation to the Cypress Point residential development. This will allow for greater flexibility in Architectural Controls at this location.
