DELEGATIONS

ITEMS FOR ACTION

CORPORATE SERVICES

City Council approved spending in the amount of \$1,573,254.28 for the period of May 6th – May 20th, 2021.

INFRASTRUCTURE & OPERATIONS

City Council awarded the Landscaping portion of the Active Transportation Expansion Project to SMG Operating Ltd. based on unit pricing to an upset fee of \$542,036.68 (a 10% contingency is included, PST is included and GST is excluded).

COMMUNITY SERVICES

City Council approved the reallocation of \$751,518.00 from the Safe Restart Program to:

- be distributed to sport, recreation and culture community partners;
- be used to replace the Living Sky Community Development Corporation Grant for 2021 – 2022;
- complete a Community Strategic Plan; and
- support the municipal share of the Active Transportation Expansion Project.

CITY CLERK

To accommodate vacation time for Administration and Members of Council, City Council cancelled their regular meetings scheduled for July 12th and August 9th, 2021. In the event a time-sensitive matter should arise, a special Council Meeting can be called with Council’s consent.

BYLAWS

City Council passed a number of Bylaws in advance of Tax Notices being mailed to property owners. These Bylaws are:

- Bill No. 3 – 202: To fix and levy the Annual Rate of Taxation and the Base Tax for 2021.
- Bill No. 4 – 2021: To establish the Mill Rate Factors.
- Bill No. 5 – 2021: To provide for the creation of a Special Tax related to the funding of the Meadows Long Term Care Facility.
- Bill No. 6 – 2021: To provide for the exemption of taxation for the 2021 assessment of certain properties (namely, charities and non-profit organizations).
