ITEMS FOR ACTION

CORPORATE SERVICES

City Council approved spending in the amount of \$864,707.82 for the period of April 24th – May 5th, 2021.

INFRASTRUCTURE & OPERATIONS

City Council approved the Active Transportation Expansion project to be included in the 2021 Capital Budget in the amount of \$4,658,268.00. The project will recieve funding through the new COVID-19 Resilience Stream of the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program (ICIP), including:

- 40% funding from the Government of Canada
- 33.33% funding from the Government of Saskatchewan, and
- 26.67% funding from the City of Swift Current.

In addition, City Council awarded the Active Transportation Pathway and Sidewalk Expansion contract to Mobile Paving, based on unit pricing, to an upset value of \$2,451,046.28.

City Council awarded the contract for the Water Treatment Plant Roof Rehabiliatation project to Duncan Roofing, Ltd. in the amount of \$108,120.00.

City Council awarded the contract for the Service Centre Roof Replacement project to Plato's Superior Roofing in the amount of \$234,973.00.

ASSET MANAGEMENT

City Council approved the purchase of a 2021 Envirosight Rover X Crawler Tractor & Camera, which will be used to assess the condition of storm and sanitary sewers, in the amount of \$126,717.70.

SWIFT CURRENT FIRE DEPARTMENT

City Council approved the purchase 15 Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus units to replace older units that no longer meet OH&S Regulations in the amount of \$125,292.00.

BYLAWS

City Council passed a Bylaw to amend text in the Architectural Controls pertaining to the Cypress Point Residential Development.
