## ITEMS FOR ACTION

### CORPORATE SERVICES

City Council approved spending in the amount of \$2,016,553.68 for the period of April 8th – 23rd, 2021.

City Council gave Notice of Motion of its intention to consider Bylaws to establish: the Mill Rate, Mill Rate Factors, a Special Levy to fund the Long Term Care facility, and the exemption of the 2021 Assessment of certain properties.

### INFRASTRUCTURE & OPERATIONS

City Council awarded the CPR Storm Main Relining project to Insituform Technologies in the amount of \$199,494.00.

City Council awarded the city’s Public Transit Operational Contract to SaskAbilities from 2021 through 2025.

City Council awarded its 2021 Concrete & Paving Contract to Mobile Paving, Ltd., to a total upset fee of \$1,128,000.00

### COMMUNITY SERVICES

City Council approved the purchases of a Greens Mower, Fairway Mower and Debris Blower from Martin Deerline for a total cost of \$118,094.71.

### CITY CLERK

City Council amended the Minutes from the January 11th, 2021 Council Meeting to accurately reflect the newly-adopted Council Remuneration Policy.
