CORPORATE SERVICES

City Council approved spending in the amount of \$2,142,580.49 for the period of June 4th to 16th, 2021.

OFFICE OF THE CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER

City Council approved an agreement with J & P Bardahl Investments, Ltd. that will see the transfer of land and payment to the City as settlement for services, the continued re-zoning of said property by the City, and the donation of an additional parcel of land to the City.

City Council approved the distribution of the City's \$30,555 SGI Rebate to be donated equally to The Center, the Salvation Army Food Bank and the Canadian Mental Health Association.

INFRASTRUCTURE & OPERATIONS

City Council awarded the supply of eight (8)
Padmounted Phase 3 Transformers to be used by
Light & Power to Carte International Inc. in the
amount of \$184,859.76.

City Council approved the supply of lighting materials for the Active Transportation Expansion projects as follows:

- Foundations Anchors: Anixter Power Solutions \$133,552.58
- LED Bollard, Park & Street Lights: Gescan \$227,014.90
- Park & Street Light Poles: Metalogalva NA Inc. \$108,491.00

City Council awarded the contract for electrical work related to the Active Transportation Expansion project to Riverside Electric, Ltd. to an upset fee of \$105,459.40.

City Council awarded the contract for the construction of a Pump Station for the City's Residual Management program to Trans Canada Construction in the amount of \$1,665,838.76.

City Council awarded the 2021 portion of Phase 1 of the Swift Current Airport's Primary Runway Rehabilitation Project to HJR Asphalt in the amount of \$353,923.40.
