ITEMS FOR ACTION

CORPORATE SERVICES

City Council approved spending in the amount of \$2,239,881.12 for the period of July 10th to 23rd, 2021.

City Council approved spending in the amount of \$1,646,314.44 for the period of July 24th to 28th, 2021.

INFRASTRUCTURE & OPERATIONS

City Council awarded the contract for the pipeline construcion for the Rural Water Pipeline East Upgrades to Knudsen Excavating of Swift Current, SK for a total amount of \$299,044.02 (10% contingency included, PST included, GST excluded). This pipeline, when coupled with the construction of a new pumphouse (to be tendered in late August), will ultimately become the South Rural Water Pipeline, and will resolve water outages in the Warkentin Subdivision, allow for capacity of up to 120 additional subscribers and free up supply on the East Rural Water Pipeline.

City Council awarded the contract for the Active Transportation Expansion: Honda Slope Bank Rehabilitation to Boire Trucking of Gravelbourg, SK based on lump sum pricing to an upset fee of \$266,000.00 (PST included, GST excluded). This project involves the stabalization of the creek bank in three (3) locations in the vicinity of Regier Honda prior to the installation of the Boardwalk, and is one segment of the \$5,996,516.00 Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program (ICIP) that the City entered into with the Governments of Canada and Saskatchewan.

COMMUNITY SERVICES

City Council approved the implementation of the Safe Restart Program Funding Application that will offer a one-time grant to City of Swift Current non-profit and volunteer-based organizations that aim to provide programs and services that support:

- Economic, Cultural & Social Development;
- Justice & Health Initiatives;
- Senior & Youth Programming; and/or
- Community Recreation-based Infrastructure Development and Maintenance
