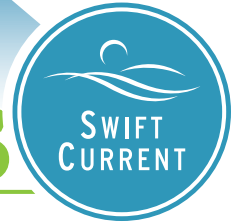


# COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

### CORPORATE SERVICES

City Council approved General Revenue Fund disbursements in the amount of \$3,043,082.18 for the period of September 10th to 23rd, 2021.

### PLANNING & GROWTH DEVELOPMENT

City Council approved the purchase of approximately 160 acres of land located north of the existing Saskatchewan Valley Subdivision to be used for future property development, at a purchase price of \$10,700.00 per acre.

The total purchase price is \$2.7 million, with \$1 million due at closing and the remaining \$1.7 million due September 30th, 2022.
