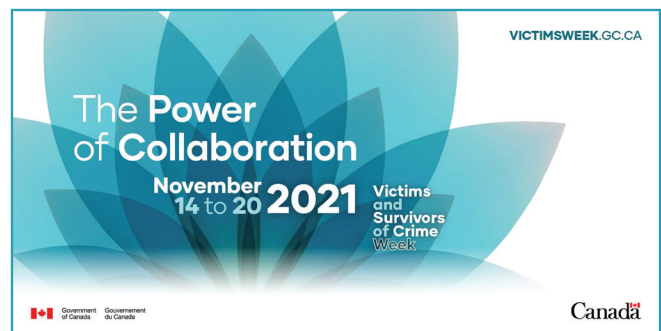
CITY CLERK
