ITEMS FOR ACTION

CORPORATE SERVICES

City Council approved General Revenue Fund disbursements in the amount of \$1,875,407.56 for the period of November 4th to 18th, 2021.

CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER

City Council made notice of motion that it intends to consider a borrowing bylaw for financing within General Government and Utility Operations. In order to complete the provincially regulated Water Treatment Plant Residual Management project, an additional \$2,550,000.00 is required; however, there is \$907,988.00 available in the Light & Power dividend that can be reallocated to the Water/Wastewater utility. Therefore, to complete the project, \$1,642,012.00 in additional debt is required.

City Council made notice of motion that it intends to consider a borrowing bylaw for financing within General Government and Utility Operations in the amount of \$14,800,000.00 to allow the City to expand its electrical franchise area. This debt will be serviced by the customers within the expanded franchise area through utility payments, and will have no impact on City taxpayers.

INFRASTRUCTURE & OPERATIONS

City Council awarded the supply and delivery of chemicals for 2022 water treatment requirements as follows:

- Potassium Permanganate, Liquid Fluoride, Chlorine Liquified Gas and Caustic Soda to ClearTech Industries of Regina, SK.
- Activated Carbon to Brenntag Canada of Toronto, ON.
- Liquid Alum to Chem Trade West of Saskatoon, SK.

COMMUNITY SERVICES

City Council approved an average 5% increase to user rates at the Chinook Golf Course.

CITY CLERK

City Council cancelled the Council meeting scheduled for Monday, December 27th, 2021, as it falls on a Statutory Holiday and is generally a quiet time of year.
