CORPORATE SERVICES

City Council approved General Revenue Fund disbursements in the amount of \$2,219,260.62 for the period of January 1st to 13th, 2022.

CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER

City Council authorized the signing of the City's Declaration of Eligibility with the Government of Saskatchewan's Ministry of Government Relations. This confrims that the City meets all requirements to be eligible to receive the provincial Municipal Revenue Sharing Grant.
