## ITEMS FOR ACTION

### CORPORATE SERVICES

City Council approved General Revenue Fund disbursements in the amount of \$2,444,282.52 for the period of February 24th to March 10th, 2022.

### INFRASTRUCTURE & OPERATIONS

City Council approved recommendations to support the Infrastructure Canada - Active Transportation Fund Capital Stream application and to agree to meet the terms and conditions therein.

### COMMUNITY SERVICES

City Council awarded the purchase of a 2022 Diesel Tractor to Full Line Ag of Swift Current.

### HUMAN RESOURCES

City Council approved the CUPE Local 183 Collective Agreement. The four-year contract, expiring in 2024, includes a signing bonus for hours worked in 2021, and wage increases of:

- 1.5% effective February 28th, 2022
- 2.0% effective December 19th, 2022
- 2.5% effective December 18th, 2023

### BUDGET

City Council approved the 2022 City of Swift Current Municipal Budget in the following amounts:

Operating & Utility Expenses: \$66,318,317  
Capital Expenditures: \$17,023,690  
TOTAL: \$83,342,061

The 2022 Municipal Budget will result in a 2.15% increase to property taxes.

In addition, a 1% increase to water & sewer rates (on top of the annual 2.0% increase) is required and a 20% Capital Surcharge for Rural Water Pipeline Customers.

Mayor Bridal reported that by the end of 2022, approximately \$5.75 million of principal debt will be removed from our ledger.
