A Public Hearing was held in connection with an application with respect to the proposed development of a Cannabis Retail Store at 42D Central Avenue North in accordance with Zoning Bylaw No. 24 – 2014. Three (3) presentations were made.

ITEMS FOR ACTION

CORPORATE SERVICES

City Council approved General Revenue Fund disbursements in the amount of \$1,242,316.56 for the period of April 23 to May 5, 2022.

INFRASTRUCTURE & OPERATIONS

A scope change was approved to amend the 2022 Asphalt & Concrete Contract with Mobile Paving relating to the completion of top lift at a cost of \$158.320.35.

INFRASTRUCTURE & OPERATIONS (CONT')

City Council awarded a three (3) year Composting Operations Contract to Les Giesbrecht of Swift Current, SK, at an annual cost of \$142,450. Overall, the composting program will save approximately \$179,000 in airspace value at the landfill, and reduce greenhouse gas emissions generated by the landfill.

City Council awarded the purchase of the R1 Grader replacement to Finning Canada of Swift Current, SK, in the amount of \$402,232.98 net cost including the trade-in.

City Council awarded the purchase of the R15 Sweeper replacement to Raymax Equipment Sales Ltd. of Calgary, AB, in the amount of \$378,738 net cost including trade-in.

The Truck Route Bylaw received three readings, and is now known as Bylaw No. 1-2022. It will go into effect on May 17, 2022.

NEW BUSINESS

The Community Policing Report for April 2022 was received and filed.
