ITEMS FOR ACTION

CORPORATE SERVICES

City Council approved General Revenue Fund disbursements in the amount of \$3,061,683.65 for the period of July 12 to 27, 2022 and \$3,522,342.09 for the period of July 28 to August 5, 2022.

INFRASTRUCTURE & OPERATIONS

A notice of motion was given, advising the public of City Council's intent to adjust the electric current usage rates with a 4% system average increase, effective September 1, 2022 billing period.

A notice of motion was given, advising the public of City Council's intent to amend the water and wastewater rates with an increase of 1% effective September 1, 2022 billing period. The existing annual January 1st increase of 2% will remain in effect annually.

City Council awarded the three (3) year Landfill Operation Services Contract with two (2) options to extend for an additional two (2) years each to GFL Environmental Inc. at a fixed annual cost of \$353,000 with an additional \$11/tonne fee.

City Council approved the Electrical Service Agreement with SaskPower. This agreement sets the terms and conditions for the purchase of electricity from SaskPower and sale of electricity by Light & Power.

City Council approved the Purchase and Sale Agreement for the expanded electrical franchise area with SaskPower.

COMMUNITY SERVICES

Councillor Christiansen and Mayor Bridal declared a conflict of interest and exited Council Chambers prior to the presentation of the next report.

City Council awarded the Accessible Washroom - New Southside Park project to Bridal Builders of Swift Current, SK in the sum of \$126,911.68.

PLANNING & GROWTH DEVELOPMENT

City Council approved the lease agreement between the City of Swift Current and the SPCA Swift Current for a 30-year period.

City Council approved the proposed subdivision for bare land condiminiums at 435 & 437 - 7th Ave NE to create individual ownership for each dwelling unit.
