

### WHAT IS A HEAVY VEHICLE ROUTE?

A Heavy Vehicle Route is an assigned route within the City that vehicles exceeding 9000kg must follow. Vehicles are allowed to deviate from the route for the purposes of pick up/deliveries, fueling or service. However, they must travel by most direct route to and from the Heavy Vehicle Route.

### WHAT IS AN OVER-DIMENSIONAL ROUTE?

An Over-dimensional Route is an assigned route within the City that vehicles exceeding the maximum allowable dimensions must follow. Maximum allowable dimensions can be found in the bylaw.

### WHAT IS A DANGEROUS GOODS ROUTE?

A Dangerous Goods Route is an assigned route within the City that vehicles transporting dangerous goods are required to follow.

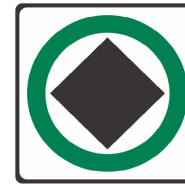

## TRUCK & DANGEROUS GOODS ROUTE

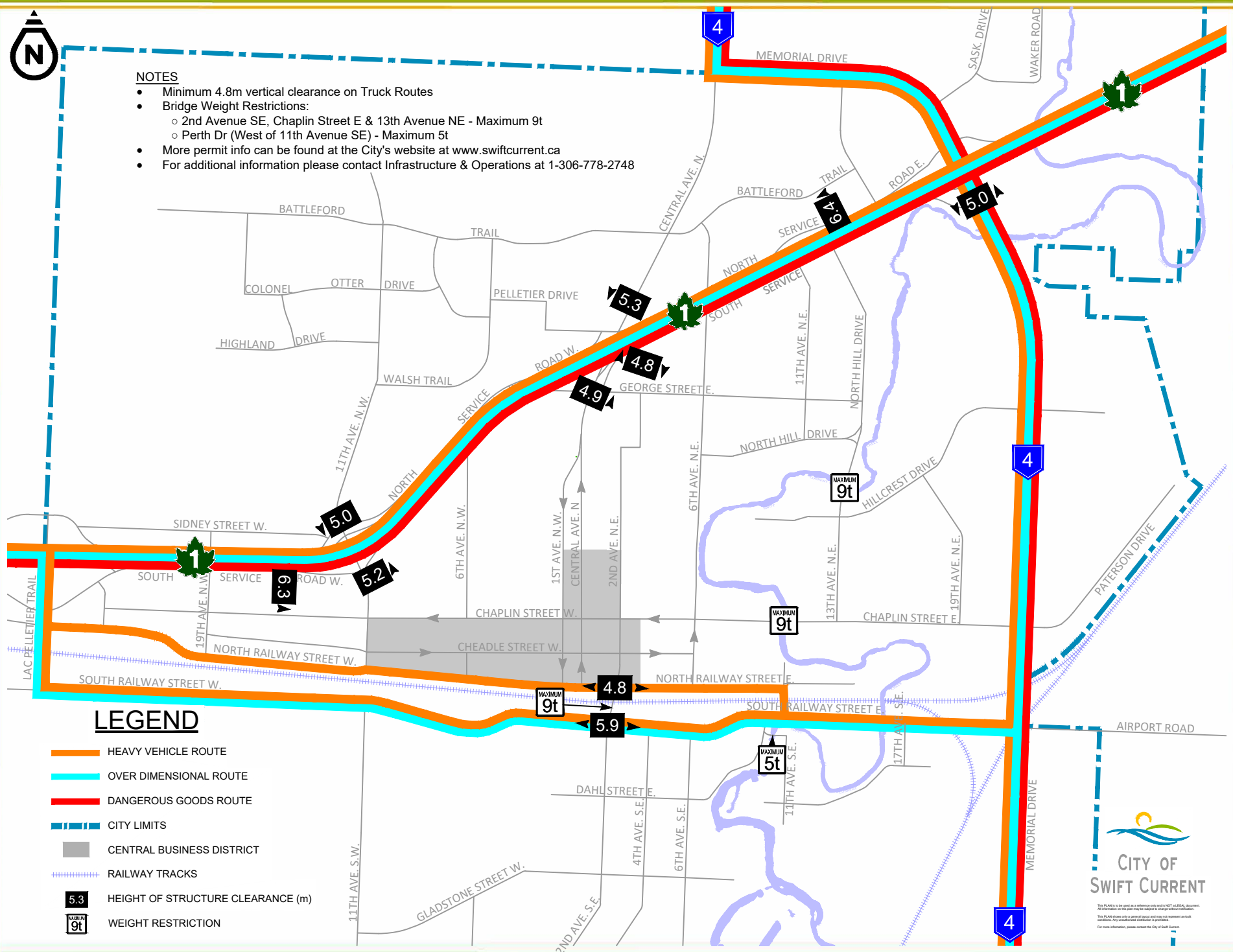

- Minimum 4.8m vertical clearance on Truck Routes
- Bridge Weight Restrictions:
  - 2nd Avenue SE, Chaplin Street E & 13th Avenue NE - Maximum 9t
  - Perth Dr (West of 11th Avenue SE) - Maximum 5t
