ITEMS FOR ACTION

CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER

City Council declared that the local emergency may now be terminated. High water levels have subsided and barricades are being removed.

INFRASTRUCTURE & OPERATIONS

City Council awarded the 10th Avenue Northeast Infrastructure Replacement Contract to Knudsen Excavating Ltd. of Swift Current, SK, based on unit rate pricing to an upset fee of \$724,433.92.

City Council awarded the 2023 Paving and Concrete Contract to United Paving Ltd. of Swift Current, SK, based on unit pricing to a total upset fee of the approved budget of \$1,858,705.64.

City Council awarded the 2023 Asphalt Maintenance Contract to United Paving Ltd. of Swift Current, SK based on unit prices to a total upset fee of \$400,000.

SWIFT CURRENT FIRE DEPARTMENT

City Council approved the application to the Ministry of Government Relations to be designated an eligible assistance area under the *Provincial Disaster Assistance Program (PDAP)*, which provides financial assistance for restoring essential services and property as a result of substantial damages caused by flood water that occured during April 11th to 21st, 2023.
