ITEMS FOR ACTION

CORPORATE SERVICES

City Council approved General Revenue Fund disbursements in the amount of \$2,241,156.56 for the period of June 13 to June 27, 2023.

City Council approved General Revenue Fund disbursements in the amount of \$6,770,800.21 for the period of June 28 to July 13, 2023.

CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER

City Council waived notice of its intention to adopt a Whistleblower Bylaw.

PLANNING AND GROWTH DEVELOPMENT

City Council approved the rate increase for the landing fees, parking fees and hangar lease rates at the Swift Current Airport.

City Council approved the proposed consolidation of Parcels 6 & 7, Plan 102236688 and that the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized to sign the Certificate of Approval.

City Council approved a list of persons to act as Building Officials for the City of Swift Current.

COMMUNITY SERVICES

City Council approved a three year (3) Lease Agreement with the Swift Current Curling Club for the 2023-2024, 2024-2025 and 2025-2026 seasons.

BYLAWS

Bill No. 11 – 2023 being a Bylaw to amend Zoning Bylaw No. 24 – 2014 received a first reading. This amendment allows day care centers as a Permitted Principal Use in the C2–Neighbourhood Commercial District, C3–Highway Commercial District, and C4–Shopping Center Commercial District.

Bill No. 12 – 2023 being a Bylaw to establish a Whistleblower Bylaw received three readings.
