ASSESSMENT NOTICES

WHAT DOES THIS NOTICE MEAN?

It is notice of the assessed value of your property used as a starting point to calculate your property tax for the current year. Property owners are taxed a percentage of their Assessed Property Value.

HOW WAS THE VALUE CALCULATED?

There are five (5) main factors that determine your property's assessed value: location, lot size, living area, age of property, and construction materials. There are also some additional factors beyond those listed that may add to or subtract from your Assessed Property Value.
