ITEMS FOR ACTION

CORPORATE SERVICES

City Council approved General Revenue Fund disbursements in the amount of \$2,271,372.71 for the period of March 7 to March 21, 2024.

City Council gave Notice of Motion of their intention to consider the following bylaws:

- a bylaw to establish the mill rate;
- a bylaw to establish the mill rate factors;
- a bylaw to establish a special levy for funding of the long-term care facility; and
- a bylaw to exempt the 2024 assessment of certain properties.

INFRASTRUCTURE & OPERATIONS

City Council awarded a three-year contract for cover soils for the City's East Municipal Landfill to Southern Star Trucking and Excavation Ltd. of Swift Current, SK at an annual cost of \$89,280 (PST exempt, GST excluded) and authorized the

Mayor and City Clerk to sign the contract.

City Council awarded a three-year Composting Operations contract, with two options to extend, to GFL Environmental Inc. at an annual cost of \$83,718.10 (PST exempt, GST excluded) and authorized the Mayor and City Clerk to sign the contract.
