PUBLIC HEARINGS

A Public Hearing was held in connection with Council's intention to consider a discretionary use application for a change to an existing discretionary use in a C3 – Highway Commercial District for the proposed building addition at Victory Family Church.

One presentation was made supporting the application.

ITEMS FOR ACTION

CORPORATE SERVICES

City Council approved the General Revenue Fund disbursements in the amount of \$2,437,377.92 for the period of July 11 to July 23, 2024.

City Council approved the General Revenue Fund disbursements in the amount of \$2,910,814.95 for the period of July 24 to August 6, 2024.

OFFICE OF THE CITY CLERK

City Council approved scheduling the swearing in ceremony on November 18, 2024 and the inaugural meeting of the newly elected council on November 25, 2024.

PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT

City Council approved the change to an existing discretionary use application for the expansion of the daycare center located at 287 – 13th Avenue NE to include the adjacent property at 285 – 13th Avenue NE, and that the Development Permit for a change-of-use be issued following final plan review and approval, subject to specific conditions.

City Council approved the discretionary use application for the twelve-room Boarding House/ Student Residence located at 45 Sidney Street E and that the Development Permit for a change-of-use be issued following final plan review and approval, subject to specific conditions.

City Council approved the change to an existing discretionary use application for the building addition to the Religious Institution located at 1100 – 5th Avenue NE and that the Development Permit be issued following final plan review and approval, subject to specific conditions.

City Council gave notice of their intent to consider a discretionary use application in a R1 – Single-Detached Dwelling Residential District for a proposed Daycare Center located at 610 – 19th Avenue NE.
