

Jumpstart is a community-based charitable program that helps kids in need participate in organized sports and recreational activities like dance, soccer and swimming. Swift Current Jumpstart works closely with the KidSport committees in the southwest to enhance the financial support to families in all our communities.

Guidelines for Funding:

- Funding is based on the child's financial need. Goal is to help those children who would not have been able to participate in a physical activity without the assistance of Canadian Tire Jumpstart.
- Eligible children are between the ages of 4 and 18 years.
- Children from any community in southwest Saskatchewan are eligible.
- To be considered, the activity must include physical activity.
- Funding is provided for individuals, not to teams; and is paid to the directly to the organization.
- No funds are to be used to pay for administration or for any other use.
- Up to \$300 per child can be allocated per season.
- Funding must be for a sustained program that lasts a season or minimum of 5 weeks with a minimum of one session per week.
- Camps which are a minimum of 5 days in length, and have a physical activity focus are eligible.
- Funding is available for members of the same family.
- Funding can be provided to the same child for successive seasons, although the goal is that Jump Start continues to fund new children.
- Funding priority is registration fees. Should funds allow, the committee will consider equipment costs
- Each applicant is required to complete the Jump Start application form in full.
- Applications can be picked up at Canadian Tire Customer Service, or at City of Swift Current Community Services Department www.swiftcurrent.ca.
- Endorsement *must* come from a professional. Family members, coworkers or the organization receiving the funds *can not* endorse the application.
- Approvals are not retroactive. Applications must be submitted before the start of the season.

Applications are accepted: January 1st - May 15th July 1st - November 1st

We are only able to accept applications during the spring and fall timelines noted above. Early submissions are encouraged; however, the approved payment will be based on the Chapter's funding deadlines noted above.
